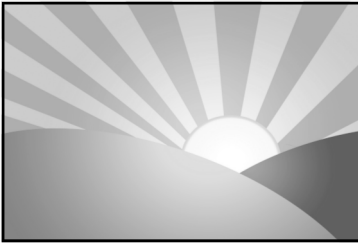

Blairsdien-Graeagle, CA 96103

Located at the edge of the northern Sierra Nevada's Mohawk Valley along California's Scenic Hwy 70, University of Earth's campus is nestled at the foot of an ancient sacred mountain landscape with nearly a mile of the scenic Middle Fork of the Feather River winding through its forty acres. The campus is an ideal location for meditation & reflection. The weekend will consist of speakers, large and small group sharing, journaling and discussion within a loving fellowship.

Space is limited, so get your registration in early.

Directions to University of Earth: **Due to our rural location, do not try to “GPS” or “MapQuest” our address. It will not direct you to the retreat center.**

From Reno: Take US-395 north towards Susanville
Take Exit 8 and turn left onto CA-70 west towards Portola/Quincy
After 33 miles, at the CA-70/CA-89 Junction (there is a Big White Barn on that corner), continue west on 70 and we are 2.9 miles on the left from the Junction.

From Grass Valley/Nevada City: Take Hwy 49 east past North San Juan
Continue on 49 through Downieville & Sierra City to the Hwy 49 – Hwy 89 junction*

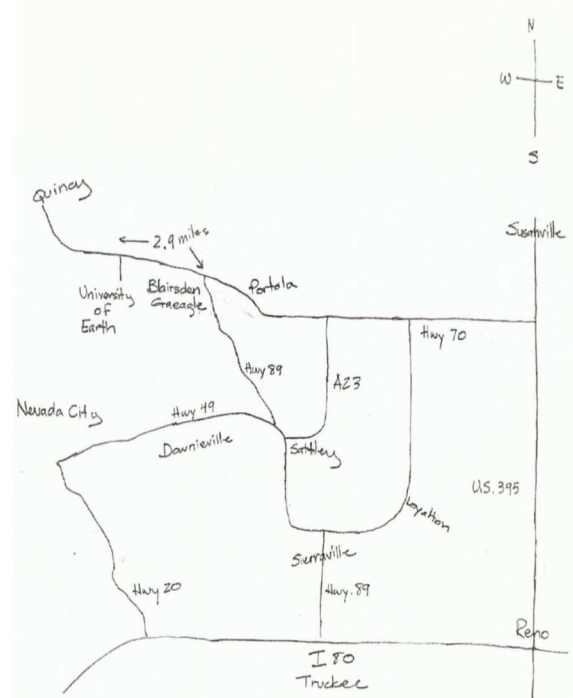
Turn left on Hwy 89 toward Graeagle/Quincy
After driving through the quaint “red” mill town of Graeagle, turn left (west towards Quincy) at the junction of CA-70/CA-89 just after the town of Blairsdien

This is important: From the 70/89 junction, after 2.9 miles look for a paved driveway on the left, right after a highway pullout.

*There is a short cut over Gold Lake Rd. when it is not closed due to snow. Take a left at Bassetts, follow Gold Lake Rd. to Hwy 89. Turn left at Hwy 89 through Graeagle

From Truckee: Take exit 188B for CA-89/CA-267 north towards Sierraville. Stay on CA-89 north towards Sierraville. Left on CA-49/CA-89 at Sierraville. Slight right on CA-89 towards Calpine/Graeagle/Quincy (if you stay to the left you will end up in Sierra City and Downieville)
After driving through the quaint “red” mill town of Graeagle, turn left (west towards Quincy) at the junction of CA-70/CA-89 just after the town of Blairsdien

This is important: From the 70/89 junction, after 2.9 miles look for a paved driveway on the left, right after a highway pullout.
